Leading café and restaurants roll out sumptuous pre and post theater dining options

Singapore (April 01, 2011) – As the Grand Theater and the Sands Theater at Marina Bay Sands celebrate a successful opening month with headlining acts, the restaurants and cafes at The Shoppes at Marina Bay Sands have rolled out an exciting array of dining options for theater-goers.

Located on top of the iconic Sands SkyPark, **KU DÉ TA** constantly injects new energy into the city's nightlife, offering guests a spectacular location for pre or post theater dinner and drinks. With world class cuisine prepared by an international team of chefs, guests are given the option of either indoor or al fresco dining with 230 seats to choose from. Theater goers enjoy an exclusive 10 percent off their total bill.

TWG Tea, the finest luxury tea brand in the world, has created an elegant and exclusive four-course pre-theater dinner menu. At S\$50++ diners can start off dining experience with the soup of the day, followed by main course from a choice of four. The superb choices are *Veal Medallion*, sautéed veal served with green asparagus and apples drizzled with a rich veal sauce infused with Pink Garden Tea or *Carré d'Agneau*, rack of lamb accompanied by a stewed bell pepper and zucchini ratatouille served with a rich Red of Africa Tea infused sauce, or the *Roast Apricot Cod*, a delicate cod fillet served with potato purée sprinkled with Matcha Tea accompanied by a rich Apricot Tea infused sauce or the *Chai Sea Bass*, fillet of sea bass served with puréed pumpkin drizzled with a Red Chai Tea infused cream enhanced with notes of citrus fruit. Guests can finish off the meal with a tantalizing Tea Infused Patisserie and a tea from the salon's extensive list.

Around the corner and located on second level of the Sands Casino building, **Hide Yamamoto**, the fine dining Japanese restaurant, offers guests two exquisite set menus. For S\$88++ diners will kick off their meals with an appetizer, a main course which includes choices of the grilled Australian Beef Tenderloin, followed by a hearty ramen. For an additional S\$10++, guests are treated to the *Teppanyaki* menu, which offers an even wider choice of delights, including the Kurobuta pork collar.



Directly across and just a 10-minute walk to the theaters is the **Imperial Treasure Fine Chinese Cuisine** restaurant. This elegant restaurant offers both a pre and post theater menu. With menus at \$108++ the chef has created a decadent five course indulgence including the pan-fried sea bass fillet and braised sliced abalone with vegetable as some of the highlights.

The three set meal priced at \$55++ provides a dining experience in an elegant setting offering diners an international selection, including a choice of duck confit.

Todai, the 12,000sq feet sushi and seafood buffet restaurant, boasts a wide assortment of cold dishes including sushi and snow crab legs to green mussels and cocktail shrimps. Diners looking to enjoy the outdoors and take in the stunning view of the Singapore city skyline can head to **South Coast**, a contemporary bar and bistro located along the Central Promenade. Caffé B, an authentic Italian fine dining restaurant and bar spread across two floors has prepared an exclusive menu with an antipasti followed by a choice of main, ranging from five signature pastas and three risottos. The meal will be accompanied by one complimentary glass of wine or one cocktail, which can be enjoyed at the outdoor bar located at the promenade.
