Spellbinding September sees complimentary programs at ArtScience Museum

Singapore (4 September 2012) – As *Harry Potter: The Exhibition* enters its last month in Singapore, a series of complimentary workshops have been organized at ArtScience Museum for all museum goers. From 1 to 30 September, visitors can take part in classes that will engage their creative minds, enhancing their unique ArtScience Museum experience. Beginning on 5 September, each session will be open to 30 participants.

The <u>Vitruvian Man</u> class, inspired by none other than Leonardo da Vinci's famous drawing, will be held on every Sunday in September. The class seeks to examine the relationship between arts, science, mathematics, proportion and symmetry. Attendees can embark on their own discovery journey and find out if they are the right 'Proportions of Man' at the sessions. Each session of the Vitruvian Man workshop accepts up to 20 participants.

Part educational toy and part stylish accessory, the Hama Beads have often been used to encourage creative play with children. On every Friday in the month of September, participants can look forward to designing their own chic mosaic at the <u>Hama Beads</u>



<u>Workshop</u>. Attendees will be able to bring back their personalized kaleidoscopic accessories as souvenirs.

Visitors can also enjoy The ArtScience of Letter Writing, the ArtScient!st, Silkscreen Printing, and Special Effects Makeup workshops.
