Marina Bay Sands Hotel and Sands SkyPark®

Marina Bay Sands Hotel consists of three unique hotel towers crowned by the magnificent Sands SkyPark. With over 2,500 rooms and suites, Marina Bay Sands Hotel is the biggest hotel in Singapore. The rooms offer views of the South China Sea or Marina Bay and the Singapore skyline.

Marina Bay Sands Hotel at a glance:

- 2,561 rooms and suites, 55 floors, 18 different room types
- Includes 230 luxury suites that come with butler service and privileged access to VIP areas
- An array of dining experiences at the hotel include:
 - *Rise*, an all-day restaurant featuring world cuisine, emphasizing South East Asian specialties. *Rise* offers buffet and a-la-carte breakfast, lunch, dinner and late supper.
 - *Rise Lounge*, a lobby lounge serving light fare, express continental breakfast, afternoon tea and refined wines and cocktails.
 - *Fuse*, a lobby bar that is the energy center of the atrium, offering mood and vibe music
 - *SweetSpot*, an espresso bar, bakery and cake shop.
 - *Jin Shan (金山楼)*, a high-end restaurant serving exquisite Chinese fare.
 - 24-hour In-Room Dining, which offers an eclectic menu selection to tantalize the palate of guests from every region and traditional comfort food.

Other highlights of the hotel include:

- The hotel has sloping towers and straight legs connected at Level 23 to form a single building. In hotel tower 1, the slope is as steep as 26 degrees, making it one of the most complex hotels ever built.
- Marina Bay Sands built one new hotel floor every 4 days, the fastest pace ever for a development of this scale in Singapore.

The best views of Singapore - Sands SkyPark

The Sands SkyPark is an architectural masterpiece sitting on top of the three hotel towers at Marina Bay Sands. This 1.2 hectare tropical oasis is longer than the Eiffel Tower is tall and large enough to park four-and-a-half A380 jumbo jets. It extends to form the one of the world's largest public cantilevers.
