# MARINA BAY SANDS OFFERS MORE THAN 1,200 JOBS OVER TWO-DAY CAREER FAIR ON 9 AND 10 MARCH

Singapore (24 February 2025) — Marina Bay Sands presents its largest career fair of the year on 9 and 10 March 2025, as it gears up in its journey to build a world-class hospitality talent pool for Singapore. Over 1,200 full-time, part-time and internship positions will be available across more than 25 departments, including butlers, call centre executives, engagement ambassadors, F&B specialists, housekeeping attendants, limousine drivers and technicians.

As the integrated resort makes steady progress in its US\$1.75 billion multi-year transformation and unveils more luxury hospitality experiences, new roles have emerged, including Executive Chef and Tea Master positions at <u>Jin Ting Wan</u> (金蜓湾), Marina Bay Sands' first and fully owned and operated authentic Cantonese fine dining destination that is set to debut this Summer.

To be held on 9 and 10 March at Marina Bay Sands Expo & Convention Centre, Level 1, Hall B, the walk-in career fair follows the success of the 2024 edition, recording around 3,400 attendees during the two-day fair, with thousands of interviews conducted on the spot.

The 2025 career fair heralds a new era in Marina Bay Sands' talent acquisition journey, as it unveils a refreshed recruitment campaign 'We Take You Above Beyond'. It is in tangent with a new brand service culture programme that reflects Marina Bay Sands' commitment to exceed expectations through its brand vision, Above Beyond, which was unveiled in November 2024.

## Highlights of the career fair

Opening its doors on 9 March at 10am, the career fair will kick off with performances by Marina Bay Sands' inclusive partners, including a live band set by Yellow Ribbon Singapore and a lion dance performance by Metta School.

Throughout the fair, jobseekers can look forward to masterclasses helmed by Marina Bay Sands Team Members. Highlights include:

- 'In Pursuit of Perfection', which seeks to provide a first-hand perspective on the job of a Marina Bay Sands butler and equip participants with the skills required to provide world-class service. The resort's brigade of 160 butlers is among the largest Butler Services teams in the world. - 'Secrets of the Sommeliers', a fun and engaging session hosted by Marina Bay Sands' award-winning sommeliers who will share tips in blind tasting.
- 'Shaping the Visual World of Marina Bay Sands', a masterclass led by Marina Bay Sands' Visual Media team, where jobseekers can learn about the process that goes into orchestrating visual assets for the iconic resort, as well as tips to enhance their portfolios to stand out in today's competitive job market.

Come 10 March, jobseekers can join 'Mastering Sustainable Architecture and Building Design', a walking tour that brings them behind-the-scenes to tour sustainability initiatives located in Marina Bay Sands' back-of-house. They can learn about the smart technologies implemented to track energy and water usage and manage food waste, along with the secrets of Marina Bay Sands' art and sustainability path, reflecting the integrated resort's pursuit to reduce its environmental impact while offering world-class experiences.

As part of the resort's ongoing efforts to create a healthy pipeline of talent, students from Institutes of Higher Learning (IHLs) have been invited to join the masterclasses and sustainability tour, allowing them to gain exposure to the hospitality industry. They include recipients of the Sands Hospitality Scholarship, a US\$1 million scholarship programme between Marina Bay Sands and parent company Las Vegas Sands to nurture young hospitality talent from six IHLs.

Management consulting company Talent Plus will conduct a self-discovery workshop for jobseekers to discover their strengths and to gain a better understanding of a career path to pursue. A photobooth will also be available for jobseekers to take professional photos for their resume.
