Dance to the beats at MARQUEE Singapore

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MARQUEE Singapore is setting the stage for a bold lineup of genre-bending artists, throwback revelry and a distinctly local twist on nightlife. The coming month promises an unforgettable celebration peppered with anthemic highs, theatrical moments and nostalgic nods delivered with unrelenting kick and transporative melodies.

Festivities are set to kick off on 2 August, as global trance icon Andrew Rayel takes the stage with a performance defined by beguiling builds and explosive drops that carry heft, yet maintain a sense of smooth momentum.
