MARINA BAY SANDS KICKS OFF NEW YEAR WITH INAUGURAL SANDS COMEDY SEASON

From 31 January to 5 February, the integrated resort will host its first-ever Chinese language comedy festival featuring a star-studded cast of comedy talents.



The inaugural Sands Comedy Season features an exhilarating line-up of Chinese comedy acts and performances making their debuts in Singapore.

Singapore (21 January 2026) – Comedy season lands at Marina Bay Sands on 31 January as the integrated resort launches its first-ever Chinese language comedy festival *Sands Comedy Season* (金沙喜剧季).

Co-organised with Clover Films, the event will run from 31 January to 5 February 2026 at Sands Theatre, featuring a vibrant line-up of events, including the local debut of blockbuster stage performances by China's leading comedy brands **Mahua Fun Age** (开心麻花) and **Xiaoguo Comedy** (笑果文化), as well as Singapore's comedy king, **Mark Lee** (李国煌)'s first full-length stand-up show.

The event will also see the world premiere of the Singapore-Thai co-production *3 Good Guys* (《老婆，我爱你!》), a fantasy romance comedy film starring Singaporean influencers Simonboy 江伟南, Mayiduo (马一朵), and Tommy Wong (黃立晖), and Thai influencer Fah Chatchaya Suthisuwan, as well as Grace Teo (张嘉轩), and Germaine Chow (邹宥菲).

"Comedy is a universal language, and *Sands Comedy Season* introduces a new dimension to our entertainment repertoire, complementing our year-round slate of world-class concerts, musicals and premieres," said Jeremy Bach, Senior Vice President and Chief Customer Officer, Marina Bay Sands. "Building on our strong track record of hosting leading Chinese comedy acts - including global tours by De Yun She (德云社) and Zhao Benshan (赵本山) - we are taking the experience to the next level with a dedicated Chinese language comedy festival that promises fun, laughter, and a refreshing way for audiences to enjoy live entertainment."




Chaos and comedy collide in Mahua Fun Age's uproarious The Count of Wulong Mountain.

Kicking off the *Sands Comedy Season* on 31 January is *Mahua Fun Age* (开心麻花), one of China's most influential comedy culture brands, who will bring their iconic stage production *The Count of Wulong Mountain* ("乌龙山伯爵" -- 开心麻花) to Singapore for the first time.

Since its premiere in 2010, *The Count of Wulong Mountain* has been performed over 4,000 times in more than 50 cities across China, attracting over three million viewers. This record-breaking phenomenon is set to make its debut in Singapore at the Sands Theatre at Marina Bay Sands over two nights, from 31 January to 1 February.

Filled with clever plot twists, and vivid characterisations, the story revolves around the protagonist, Xie Xie (谢蟹), who unexpectedly inherits a fortune of one million dollars on his 30th birthday, only to be embroiled in a bank heist and forced into a chaotic escape.

Taking the stage on 3 February is Singapore's King of Comedy, **Mark Lee (李国煌)**, who will be

performing his first full-length solo stand-up comedy show in Mandarin, *Old Horses Still Have Spring* (老马也有春天), just two weeks before the Lunar New Year and the Year of the Horse.

Playing on the Chinese idiom “马到成功”, which literally means success upon the horse’s arrival, Mark likens himself to an old horse and asks: What happens when a horse has been running for a long time?

Drawing from his own life and career, *Old Horses Still Have Spring* (老马也有春天) is Mark’s unfiltered take on work, money, marriage, aging, and the relentless effort to keep up appearances. To Mark, “Spring” is not about going back to youth, but about still having the energy, cheek, and spirit to leap forward. The show also includes a special guest appearance by veteran host — and Mark’s long-time comedy partner — Marcus Chin (陈建彬). Their signature rapid-fire banter and effortless, lived-in humour are sure to delight fans who know them well.



Making its international debut on 4 February at the Sands Theatre is Xiaoguo Comedy (笑果文化)'s *Stand-Up Comedy and Friends Season 2 World Tour* (脱口秀和 Ta 的朋友们 2 海外巡演). Featuring popular Chinese punchline stars Cheng Lu (程璐), Ji Ye (继业), Xiao Qi (小奇), Sun Shu Heng (孙书恒), Xiao Si Ye (小四爷), and Shan He (山河), the show will see both new and familiar faces taking turns to deliver a fun-filled evening of laughter and entertainment.

An extension of Xiaoguo Comedy's highly successful online comedy show, Stand-Up Comedy and Friends, the World Tour has performed over 77 times in more than 20 cities across China since July 2025, with resounding success. Founded in 2015, the group is the creative powerhouse behind China's stand-up comedy boom, and has brought fresh, witty humour to millions, turning comedians into household names and giving Chinese comedy a bold new stage. Having launched several trending stand-up comedy variety shows for subscription streaming service providers based in China, their shows have a huge following and have proven to be immensely popular with young Chinese people. Some of the shows include "Roast" and "Rock & Roast".

Capping off the *Sands Comedy Season* is the world premiere of Singapore-Thailand co-production, *3 Good Guys* (《老婆，我爱你!》), which will take place on 5 February at Sands Theatre.

Starring Singaporean influencers Simonboy (江伟南), Mayiduo (马一朵), and Tommy Wong (黃立晖), and Thai influencer Fah Chatchaya Suthisawan, as well as Grace Teo (张嘉轩), and Germaine Chow (邹宥菲), *3 Good Guys* is a whimsical fantasy and romantic comedy directed by Boi Kwong (鄭子君).

The film follows groom-to-be Jeremy, whose romance is threatened by his girlfriend's disapproving mother. His best friends, Mike and Ah Bao, each carry their own marital burdens – Mike struggles with constant arguments and tension at home, while Ah Bao longs to start a family but clashes with his wife.

Desperate for luck and clarity, Jeremy visits a mystical shrine, hoping for blessings. After a few solemn prayers, the trio decided to drown their worries at a local bar, where the night turned into a blur of laughter, drinks and hazy memories.

Featuring special appearances by Mark Lee (李国煌), Thai actor Ananda Everingham and actress "Prang" Kannarun Wongkhajornkai, Singaporean social media personality Annette Lee (李安), and Malaysian singer-songwriter Dior (大颖), among others, *3 Good Guys* promises a lively, fun-filled cinematic ride from beginning to end.
