MARINA BAY SANDS HOSTS TWO-DAY CAREER FAIR ON 15 AND 16 MARCH WITH MORE THAN 1,000 JOBS

The integrated resort prepares for its next chapter of luxury hospitality with deepened talent investment, anchored by ASPIRE – a 24-month accelerated leadership journey to fast-track young professionals



From Pastry Chefs and Security Officers to Butlers and MICE professionals, Marina Bay Sands welcomes passionate hospitality professionals to explore diverse career paths and grow meaningful careers

Singapore (2 March 2026) — Marina Bay Sands will be presenting its largest career fair of the year on 15 and 16 March 2026, reinforcing its commitment to elevating Singapore's luxury hospitality landscape through diverse career opportunities and new pathways for talent development.

Over 1,000 full-time, part-time and internship positions will be available across more than 25 departments, including butlers, F&B specialists, graphic designers, housekeeping attendants, mall concierge agents and security officers. The integrated resort is also expanding its team of logistics attendants to introduce round-the-clock operations of its Autonomous Mobile Robots across nearly 70 pre-programmed routes.

Anchoring this year's fair is the [ASPIRE programme](#), a 24-month accelerated leadership journey for passionate fresh graduates to be groomed into junior leaders in 10 different career tracks spanning Hotel Operations, Convention Services, Food & Beverage Operations,

Culinary and Security Services. Successful candidates will be placed into their chosen operational track by July 2026, and receive structured rotational training, mentorship, career dialogues as well as networking and corporate projects throughout the next 24 months with Marina Bay Sands.

Ms. Chan Yit Foon, Senior Vice President of Human Resources at Marina Bay Sands, said: "We are investing in a workforce that will carry us into our next era – one defined by agility, innovation and an enduring commitment to excellence. Our annual signature career fair allows us to expand this spirit of mastery to passionate individuals at every stage of their journey, while the newly launched ASPIRE programme supports Singapore's vision of a skills-first society with reimagined pathways to develop hospitality leaders of tomorrow."

To be held on 15 and 16 March, from 10am to 7pm, at Marina Bay Sands Expo & Convention Centre, Level 1, Hall B, the walk-in career fair follows the success of the 2025 edition, which recorded around 5,500 attendees and thousands of interviews conducted on the spot.

Highlights of the Career Fair

Beyond curated zones helmed by hiring departments, the 2026 fair brings together the expertise of Marina Bay Sands' leaders and partners to engage jobseekers in main stage talks and complimentary masterclasses.

Interested graduating students and recent alumni are welcomed to join the fair's inaugural "Race & Learn" programme – a self-directed career exploration journey that brings the diverse ASPIRE career tracks to life. Participants will experience immersive touchpoints across eight insider stations helmed by Marina Bay Sands' operational leaders, designed to deepen their understanding of these career paths, build confidence and provide a valuable headstart as they chart their first steps into the dynamic industry.
