1. What is a VR Gallery?

The VR Gallery is ArtScience Museum's first ever gallery dedicated to Virtual Reality artworks and films.

2. What can I expect when I am at the VR Gallery?

The VR Gallery invites you to encounter one-of-a-kind immersive experiences from some of the world's most renowned artists, museums and film festivals.

3. What are our health advisories for the VR Gallery?

VR experiences are generally fun and safe experiences. However, depending on each individual, your comfort level may vary. If you have claustrophobia, a history of seizures, epilepsy, sensitivity to flashing lights and/or get motion sickness easily, it is not advisable or encouraged to take on this experience.

4. Is there an age restriction?

Yes, VR experiences are suitable for individuals 13 years old and above due to health and safety concerns.

7. How early should I arrive?

To create the best experience, each VR session starts on time. Please ensure you arrive at least 15 minutes before your purchased session.

8. I am late for my session. Am I still able to enter the VR Gallery?

To create the best experience, latecomers will not be admitted once the onboarding briefing starts. Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your purchased session.

9. Can I still experience the VR artworks if I am short-sighted or long-sighted?

Yes, you will be able to. We would advise visitors to wear contact lenses where possible.

10. Are there Subtitles provided in the VR artworks?

Subtitles are not provided as they can be distracting, affecting the overall VR experience. Where they are included, it is intended as part of the artwork.

11. Is the VR Gallery accessible to persons with disabilities?
