MARINA BAY SANDS HOTEL

Since opening in 2010, Marina Bay Sands has redefined the cityscape of Singapore with its distinctive architecture and unparalleled experiences. Consisting of three unique towers crowned by the magnificent Sands SkyPark, the property's iconic hotel has caught the imagination of guests from all over the world with its awe-inspiring interiors, multitude of experiences and exemplary service.

At a Glance

- With approximately 1,850 rooms and suites over 55 floors, including 775 suites across three towers, Marina Bay Sands is home to Singapore's largest hotel. Each room offers spectacular views of the South China Sea or Marina Bay and the Singapore skyline.
- In its most significant transformation to date, the integrated resort's ongoing US\$1.75 billion reinvestment programme has set a fresh benchmark in luxury hospitality. Since 2021, the refurbishment has seen the launch of an elevated hospitality experience through The Sands Collection and The Paiza Collection.
 - The Sands Collection brings hospitality to new heights of luxury, with its timeless home-away-from-home ambience. Wide-ranging room types from the Sands Premier Room with the minibar reimagined in a beautifully-designed Armoire and the Cocktail Trolley to the Sands Family Suite designed for families with young children cater to varying guest needs.
 - The rooms and suites of The Paiza Collection represent the pinnacle of timeless luxury and grandeur, occupying the highest floors of the city's landmark address and welcoming guests to a unique residential concept reminiscent of an upmarket penthouse. The array of suites includes the Horizon Suite, a spa and wellness sanctuary; the Presidential Suite with its golf simulator for in-room practice; and the Chairman Suite, a palatial three- or four-bedroom residence ideal for entertaining.
- In February 2025, The Paiza Collection earned the prestigious Forbes Travel Guide Five-Star Rating in its first year of operation.
- The array of dining experiences at the hotel include:
 - RISE, an international buffet restaurant offering breakfast, lunch and dinner.
 - The Club, the hotel's lobby lounge serving an all-day à la carte menu and an afternoon tea menu.

- Origin + Bloom, a European-inspired patisserie concept offering a diverse array of artisanal bakes, gourmet sandwiches and coffee.
- WAKUDA, a Japanese restaurant created by Michelin-starred chef Tetsuya Wakuda and award-winning restaurateur John Kunkel of 50 Eggs Hospitality Group.
- *Blossom,* a fine-dining Chinese restaurant.
- 24-hour In-Room Dining, which offers an extensive menu selection.

Design Highlights

- The hotel has sloping towers and straight legs connected at Level 23 to form a single building.
- In Tower 1, the slope is as steep as 26 degrees, making it one of the most complex hotels ever built.
- During its construction phase, Marina Bay Sands built one new hotel floor every four days, the fastest pace ever for a development of this scale in Singapore.

The Best Views of Singapore - Sands SkyPark

Sands SkyPark is an architectural masterpiece sitting on top of the three hotel towers at Marina Bay Sands. This 1.2-hectare tropical oasis is longer than the Eiffel Tower and is tall and large enough to park four-and-a-half A380 jumbo jets. It extends to form one of the world's longest public cantilevers.

Facts about the Sands SkyPark:

- Built at the height of 200 metres.
- Its lush, landscaped gardens are home to more than 700 trees and palms.
- Offers a total of 12,400 square metres of space—big enough to fit three football fields.

- A ticketed public observation deck that can host hundreds of people.
- Hotel guests have the exclusive use of a 150-metre infinity swimming pool, the world's largest outdoor pool at that height.
- A comprehensive daily wellness programme *Where Mind & Body Connect* is held at SkyPark Observation Deck for both hotel and public guests.
- Acclaimed restaurants include Spago by Wolfgang Puck, located at Tower 2, which offers Californian cuisine with global accents.
- LAVO Italian Restaurant & Rooftop Bar perches atop Tower 1, complete with a wraparound outdoor terrace, a luxurious lounge, and exciting nightlife programming including live DJ sets.
- On the other end sits $C\dot{E}$ LA VI, featuring the alfresco SkyBar & Club Lounge as well as a restaurant serving contemporary Asian cuisine.
