



Rainwater is **collected on the roof** of ArtScience Museum<sup>™</sup> and recycled in the flush water toilet systems.



Green roof on Sands SkyPark® is a 12,400m² green oasis of **250 trees and 650 plants.** 



The large art installation *Wind Arbor* by Ned Kahn doubles up as a shade for the hotel lobby.



Hotel room curtains programmed to **close in unoccupied rooms** to keep them cooler.

Sensors installed to **turn off air-conditioning** if doors are open for extended period of time.



At RISE®, herbs, plants and other food produce are grown and harvested for use in the restaurants.



Glass façade in hotel lobby maximises use of natural daylight to illuminate indoor areas.



The Rain Oculus by Ned Kahn is an artwork that **collects rainwater** inside a 700-foot-diameter acrylic bowl for recycling.



The sensors in The Shoppes detect the brightness of the sunlight indoors and adjusts the lights accordingly.



The self-closing taps and constant flow regulators in the toilets save over **350 million litres of potable water annually.** 



There are over **200 motion sensors in our meeting rooms** which help to reduce energy consumption.
